

## 2021 TEMPERANCE HILL PINOT NOIR

Temperance Hill Vineyard sits in the center of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA, has been farmed organically for two decades, and is one of the iconic vineyards of Oregon. The vineyard bridges across from the Eastern

to the Western slopes of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA, feeling the effects of the wind from all sides. Soils are predominanty volcanic, with a variety of aspects and slopes that center around two peaks, reaching to 860ft in elevation. This wine was produced from two blocks, one running down a steep East facing slope, planted in 1993, and the second from an even steeper West facing slope, originally planted in 1983. The wines from 2021 have an intense savoryness to their structure, paired with a juicy liveliness to the fruit. The vintage of 2021 was marked both by the heat of the early season (starting with the "heat-dome" just after bloom) which thickened skins on the relatively small yeilds, and by the remarkably cool and measured end to the growing season, which kept acidity and flavors lively, and alcohols moderate. Fermentation was 100% whole cluster, in 1.5 ton lots.

The 2021 single vineyard shows classic Temperance Hill fruit, dense and powerful, tannins are distinct and refined. Dark berries, cedar, velvety dense nose with loads of graceful spices. Red and black fruits in the palate, with Temperance Hill's unique blend of power and grace. This is quite seamless for such a young wine from THV, but there is an abundance of dry extract and savory structure.
