Beginning in 2012, Goodfellow Family Cellars began bottling our Heritage selections. Each bottling in this series originates from a single site, and typically a single block within the vineyard. The wines represent our most perfect marriage of new world site and old world soul. They are wines that will stand the test of time and improve within their years of rest. Our Heritage selections are our ambassadors for the quality of the terroirs in Oregon's Willamette Valley.

2015 Vintage Notes: 2015 was one of Oregon's warmest vintages, however the days ran the gamut from modestly cool to blazing hot heat spikes. Warm spring weather led to a slightly early bloom and excellent set. Summer weather was primarily sunny throughout the growing season, and harvest occurred in mid-September with little or no inclement weather. The Durant Vineyard, of which this bottling is 100%, offers up layered flavors of thyme, Bing cherry and pie spices that are lifted with vibrant acidity to create a fully balanced profile.

Goodfellow Family Cellars is a small family winery focused on world-class wines from Oregon's Northern Willamette Valley. Sustainably farmed, non-irrigated, old vines provide us the opportunity to produce intense, site specific wines with an old world intensity and character. Fruit is farmed to accentuate the singular nature of our vineyard sites. Winemaking is traditional, no cold soaks, no yeast
